



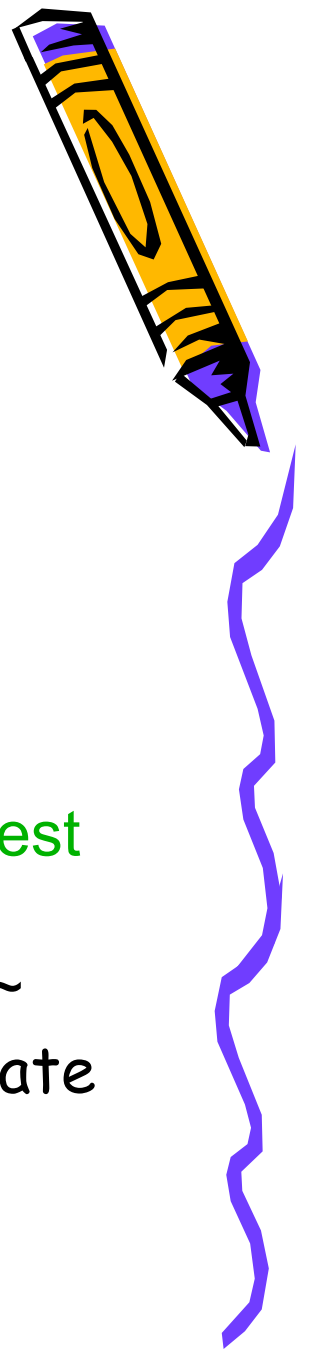

Key Elements of Collaborative Teaching for Engineering and Community

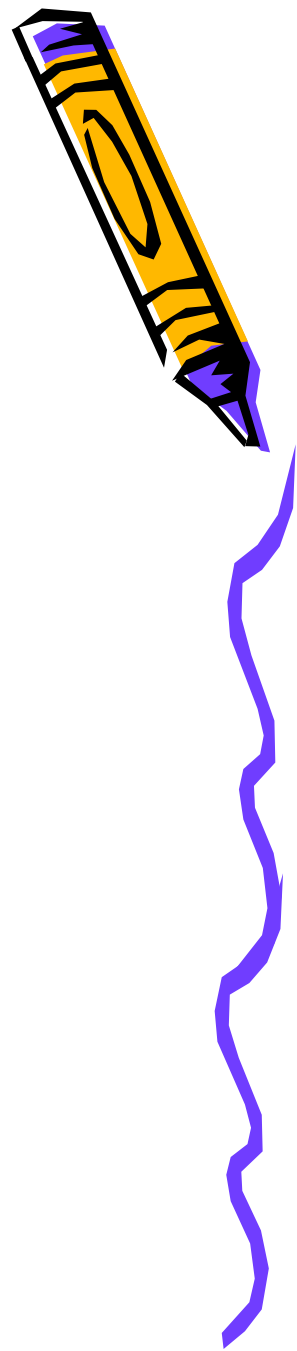
Connection between curriculum and assessment in the context of teaching specific content
